Treasurer was absent but the bank accounts are the same as last month with the exception of the additional funding of \$1,028.00 from the Gaming Corporation.

PAC would like to buy some outdoor equipment for the students. A "Super Nova" from Kompan is being looked into with a view to purchase one and have it installed by the operations crew.

Parent-Teacher night was well attended last week. End of term is Friday, April 15th and report cards are sent home on April 29<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Cobbe, Mr. Louie and a delegation of First Nations students are leaving Saturday for a cultural trip to Vancouver Island.

"Decommissioning" the Bubble was discussed. It is our understanding that it will not be torn down but will not be repaired if it falls down. Bev proposed that when the bubble no longer exists, an open post and beam structure with a roof be put over the existing floor of the Bubble. It can then be used as an outdoor classroom and as a shelter for students to "hang out" at lunch and after school.

The electronic sign on the corner of the school property is no longer functioning and therefore needs to be replaced. PAC may contribute to the cost once it is known how much that will be.

Any parent(s) interested in joining the PAC executive are invited to attend the next PAC meeting on May 11<sup>th</sup>. This will be the last PAC meeting for the year and the election of officers for the following year. It will also be Bev's last meeting as PAC Chairperson as she is stepping down at the end of this year.
